TARGET GROUP

Bridge Resource Management refresh course is a training program for ship's Masters and navigational officers.



OBJECTIVES OF THE COURSE

The trainees who successfully complete this course will have gained experience in handling ships under various conditions of specific areas prescribed by a Customer (Messina Strait transit, transiting Turkish Straits - Bosphorus, Malamocco – approaching and inbound navigation at Venezia and English Channel) and will make effective contribution to the bridge team during ship maneuvering in normal and emergency situations.



COURSE CONTENTS

The BTRM specific training course covers the following topics:

- Bridge resource management and bridge team;
- Practical planning and carrying out a voyage;
- Bridge team duties, responsibilities, teamwork;
- Workload management;
- Communication;
- Challenge and response;
- Use of authority and assertiveness;
- Involvement of human in error chain.

INCOME REQUIREMENTS

Trainees wishing to enter this course should have:

- Certificate of competence as officer in charge of a navigational watch;
- Approved Bridge Team and Resource Management certificate.

DURATION OF THE TRAINING COURSE

The duration of the BTRM specific training course is 3 working days.



COURSE LIMITATIONS

The maximum number of participants is 5 persons.

TRAINING APPROACHES AND EQUIPMENT

During training course theoretical lessons are given using PowerPoint presentations, practical tasks are conducted on the latest version of Transas bridge simulation equipment – NT-PRO 5000.

All exercises are conducted in the areas prescribed by the Customer.
