

TRAINING COURSE FOR MOORING MASTERS FOR EFFECT OF SOLITONS



TARGET GROUP

This training course primary is intended for Masters, Mates and Pilots to be engaged in ship handling operations of OTT and FPSO.



OBJECTIVES OF THE COURSE

In this course the participants should gain skills, proficiency and competence of ship handling principles, maneuvering of large size tanker ship connected in tandem with FPSO and use of different length of Hawser in various complexity and conditions.



COURSE CONTENTS

The Training course covers the following topics:

- Length of hawser from 60 to 90 meters;
- Communication type and use of communication skills;
- Approaching FPSO;
- Maneuvering and unmooring of the Ship in Soliton Conditions;
- Usage of Tugs to control heading, speed and position during approach and departure from the FPSO;
- Communication With Tugs, line handling boat, FPSO and Crew;
- Emergency maneuvering, Holding Position of the vessel with own propulsion, with tug or without, during hawser failure and hose still connected;
- Hold position after hit of Soliton.

INCOME REQUIREMENTS

Masters of Ch/off COC, STS experience or Ship Handling certificate.



DURATION OF THE TRAINING COURSE

The duration of the training course is 3 working days.



COURSE LIMITATIONS

The maximum number of participants is 4 persons.



TRAINING APPROACHES AND EQUIPMENT

During training course theoretical lessons are given using PowerPoint presentations, practical tasks are conducted on Transas NTPRO 5000 full mission simulator.
