The course is designed for shipboard personnel, who are involved into effective and efficient implementation of Company's Safety Management System. The course covers various aspects of the ISM Code apart from the Safety, Quality & Environment Management System.

Objectives of the Course

A trainee successfully completing this course will be able to:

- Explain the functional requirements of SMS.
- Demonstrate knowledge of various policies, procedures, work permits and checklists stated in the company's SMS.
- Identify Key shipboard operations
- Explain the Management of Change process
- Demonstrate knowledge of his job description as per Company manual.
- Describe Company organization & identify key persons including DPA
- Identify procedures for Audits and reviews as per the company's SMS.
- Identify corrective & preventive actions for SMS reports.

Duration of the training course

Duration of the training course – 2 days.

Course contents

The course covers but not limited by the following topics:

- Introduction to the Company;
- Introduction to the Safety management System;
- Company's Safety Management System;
- Emergency Procedures;
- Waste Management & Pollution Prevention;
- Risk Assessment and Management familiarization;
- Requirements for Audits & Inspections;
- Company work permits;
- Last Reports and analysis of non-conformities, accidents and hazardous occurrences.

Income requirements

There are no strict requirements to join the course, but it is advantage if the delegate is at least shipboard officer.

Training approaches and equipment

During training course theoretical lessons are given using PowerPoint presentations, which are supplemented with practical exercises based on Company's SMS requirements.
