

# ON-BOARD ECDIS TYPE-SPECIFIC TRAINING



## ECDIS TYPE-SPECIFIC TARGET GROUP

The course has been designed for candidates who have completed ECDIS generic training and now require equipment specific training.

## OBJECTIVES OF THE COURSE

The objective of the course: to comply with regulation I/14, paragraph 1.5 of the STCW Convention, as well as sections 6.3 and 6.5 of the International Safety Management (ISM) Code, requires companies to ensure seafarers are provided with familiarization training.

## APPROVAL



The ECDIS type-specific courses are approved by appropriate manufacturers.

## DURATION OF THE TRAINING COURSE



The duration of the ECDIS type-specific training course is 2 days, price – 350 Eur/pers.

## INCOME REQUIREMENTS:



To be assigned on ECDIS type-specific training course, participant or Company should send copies of the following documents:

- national passport,
- seamen's book,
- ECDIS Generic training course certificate.

## ON-BOARD ECDIS TYPE-SPECIFIC TRAINING COURSE

If company requires to perform on-board ECDI type-specific training:

- The duration of the ECDIS type-specific training course is 2 days, price – 350 Eur/pers
- Traveling and awaiting expenses – 350 Eur/day  
Client arranges flights, hotel, all transfers related to the service (airport <-> hotel <-> ship, etc.) and visa (if required) or covers appropriate expenses.

## COURSE LIMITATIONS FOR ON-BOARD ECDIS TYPE-SPECIFIC TRAINING COURSE

The minimum number of participants – 2 persons

## CERTIFICATES

After successful completion of the course, participants will receive ECDIS type-specific certificate approved by appropriate manufacturer.
