

AUTOMATIC EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR



TARGET GROUP

This training course primary is intended for existing seafarers who are responsible for using Automatic External Defibrillator on board ship.



OBJECTIVES OF THE COURSE

On completion of the course the trainee should be able to demonstrate sufficient understanding and knowledge of the general danger involved in shipboard operations, understand the role of first medical aid, ABC algorithm, understand how working principles Automatic External Defibrillator, understand the difference between ABC with/without Automatic External Defibrillator, train ABC in group, carry out risk assessment procedures. The trainees will gain experience of working with Automatic External Defibrillator during the practical excersises.



COURSE CONTENTS

The Training course covers the following topics:

- Introduction to health and safety legislations;
- Introduction to ABC algorithm;
- Introduction to Automatic External Defibrillator;
- Way of working for Automatic External Defibrillator;
- Creating a safety culture through teamwork;
- Case studies;
- Assesment and Discussion.
