TRAINING APPROACHES AND EQUIPMENT:



During training course theoretical lessons are given using PowerPoint presentations and industry guidelines on ECDIS familiarization. Practical tasks are conducted on Transas NT Pro 5000 ECDIS simulator, with remote access. It's mandatory to have a good internet connection and to use laptop or PC during the course. Use of tablets or mobile phones is not acceptable and will restrict the user access to training simulator.

DURATION OF THE TRAINING COURSE
